

HCC Livestock Scholarship



Are you interested in travelling overseas?

Are there areas of your business that need improving but you're not quite sure what could help?

Do you work full time in the red meat industry in Wales?

If so, the HCC Livestock Scholarship could be for you.

Every year HCC invites applications from people working full time in the Welsh red meat industry and who are interested in travelling overseas to learn and bring back new ideas to benefit your business and the wider industry in Wales.

What do you need to do?

- Identify a topic that you would like to investigate that could help improve your business and decide which country in the world you would like to visit for this purpose. For example, in 2011 an HCC scholar visited the USA to learn about processing, curing and marketing pork products. Other countries visited by HCC Scholars include New Zealand, Norway, Australia and Argentina.
- Fill in the application form which can be downloaded from the HCC website; <http://www.hccmpw.org.uk/publications/scholarship> or contact 01970 625050 and return it to Lynfa Davies (ljdavies@hccmpw.org.uk) by 29 February 2012.
- If you are shortlisted for interview you will be invited to discuss with a panel why your topic is relevant to Welsh agriculture and how your chosen destination will help you to investigate it.
- This year, all travel and subsequent expenses claims need to be made by 30 September 2012.

What do you get in return?

- Up to £3500 is available for the successful candidate(s) to assist with travel and subsistence costs for an overseas trip lasting 4-6 weeks.
- Membership of the HCC Scholarship Association. This association is made up of past scholars who are always keen to provide advice, support and contacts for new scholars when making their plans for their travels.

What do you have to do on returning from your travels?

- Write a detailed report about your scholarship trip outlining what you have learnt and how this could help your business at home.
- Give talks to local farmer groups about your trip.
- Participate in HCC Scholarship Association activities.

- Cael hyd i bwnc yr hoffech ymchwilio iddo ac a allai helpu i wella eich busnes, ynghyd â dewis gwlad yr hoffech ymweld â hi i'r diben hwnnw. Er enghraifft, yn 2011 gwnaeth ysgolor HCC teithio i UDA i ddysgu am brosesu, halltu a marchnata cynhyrchion porc. Ymhlith y gwledydd eraill y bu Ysgolorion HCC yn ymweld â nhw mae Seland Newydd, Norwy, Awstralia a'r Ariannin

- Ysgrifennu adroddiad manwl am eich taith ymchwil gan amlinellu'r hyn a ddysgwyd gennych a sut y gallai hyn helpu eich busnes gartref.
- Annerch grwpiau ffermwyr lleol am eich taith.
- Cymryd rhan yng ngweithgareddau Cymdeithas Ysgoloriaeth HCC.
