

Hill Speckled Face



Factfile:

- 450 Welsh Hill Speckled Faced ewes half of which are bred pure
- 325 acre family holding, half of which is open heather moorland, the rest either steep banks or cold, wet and stony ground
- 21 day rotational grazing (depending on conditions) is an integral part of grassland management at Rhiwfelen
- The flock is run on a 'passive low input system' – problematic ewes are never bred pure again and are put into the commercial flock.

Wyn and Chris Owen are keen to ensure that they have a sustainable business. They are aiming to maximise the output per hectare from Rhiwfelen, and are keen to ensure that the flock is producing lambs which grow well and finish quickly off pasture. With farm incomes in decline, both have pursued other avenues through part time employment whilst maintaining the sheep numbers, performance recording has helped them to achieve both.

The Owens began recording in 2001 with just 30 ewes, taking weights at 8 weeks and at about 5 months, along with ultrasound scanning of muscle and fat depths. This allowed them to improve their female lines by working out which were performing the best and to select the most efficiently producing lines as flock replacements.

Now, as part of the Welsh Hill Speckle Sire Reference Scheme, they record 230 ewes and feel that with every generation the performance of their flock is improving – not only in the quality of the dams, but in the deadweight of their progeny.

Ram lambs now finish far more successfully, with lambs easily making 20kg deadweight. This is seen as a huge bonus, since beforehand it had been a major target and a huge challenge to get a 15kg animal of the desired conformation on the hook, at a time when the market price is high, without requiring cake to finish.

The Owens are delighted with the way that recording has enabled them to improve the quality and outputs from their flock. They feel that one of the main benefits of the sire reference scheme is the use of a link ram across the group, allowing comparison over several flocks This has enabled the Group to generate credible and robust results and to make considerable progress. "When we started recording the aim was purely to improve the quality of our ewe flock," says Wyn. However, this has also resulted in many other spin off benefits. We have increased our liveweights by 3kg per head and are now selling all male lambs at deadweights of 15kg and over, much sooner than ever before. Whilst prior to recording, it was a rarity to be

able to send any lambs away before September, the first lambs now go in August."

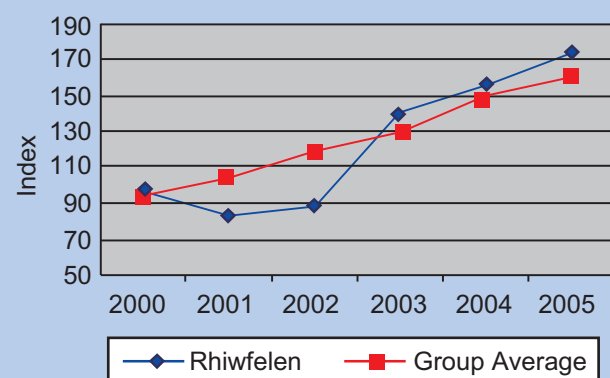
3kg extra liveweight @ £1/kg means an extra £3 per lamb as a result of using high index sires

In addition to this they are now producing rams with a high index which are also true to type and these have attracted considerable attention from other breeders.

The couple are now aiming to achieve 12 week weaning weights of over 30kg in 80 per cent of their lambs, and they are keen to try to clear as many of their lambs as possible from the farm before November.

The flock has also managed to maintain a focus on an easy care system, with all ewes lambing outdoors, and no more than 5 lambings assisted in the last 2 years.

Catapult Shepherd® is being used to help them reduce the effort of recording, enabling them to take advantage of multi-sire mating. Catapult Shepherd uses a profile of DNA markers to match lambs to their parents.

Mae 3kg o bwysau byw ychwanegol yn ôl £1/kg yn golygu £3 yr oen fel canlyniad i ddefnyddio hyrddod mynegrif uchel.

Yn ogystal â hyn maent bellach yn cynhyrchu hyrddod â mynegrif uchel sydd hefyd â gwirdeiprwydd ac mae'r rhain wedi denu cryn sylw gan fridwyr eraill.

Fodd bynnag, fel aelodau o Gynllun Cyfeirnod Hyrddod Defaid Penfrith Mynydd Cymru, maent yn cofnodi 230 o famogiaid ac yn teimlo bod perfformiad eu diadell yn gwella gyda phob cenhedlaeth – nid yn unig o ran ansawdd y mamau ond hefyd o ran pwysau marw eu hepil.

Ar hyn o bryd mae'r pâr yn anelu at gael pwysau diddyfnu 12-wythnos o dros 30kg gan 80 y cant o'u hŵyn, ac maent yn awyddus i geisio clirio cynifer o ŵyn ag y bo modd oddi ar y fferm cyn mis Tachwedd.

Mae'r ŵyn hwrdd nawr yn pesgi'n fwy llwyddiannus o lawer, gan gyrraedd 20kg yn rhwydd. Mae hyn yn cael ei ystyried yn fonws enfawr, oherwydd o'r blaen roedd yn darged pwysig ac yn her enfawr i gael anifail 15kg â'r cydffurfiad cywir ar y bach, ar adeg pan fo pris y farchnad yn uchel, heb angen dwysfyd ar gyfer y pesgi.

Cafodd y ddiadell ei rheoli hefyd gan ganolbwyntio ar system gofal hawdd, gyda'r holl famogiaid yn wyna allan, a dim mwy na phum dafad yn ymfyn cymorth wyna yn ystod y ddwy flynedd ddiwethaf.
